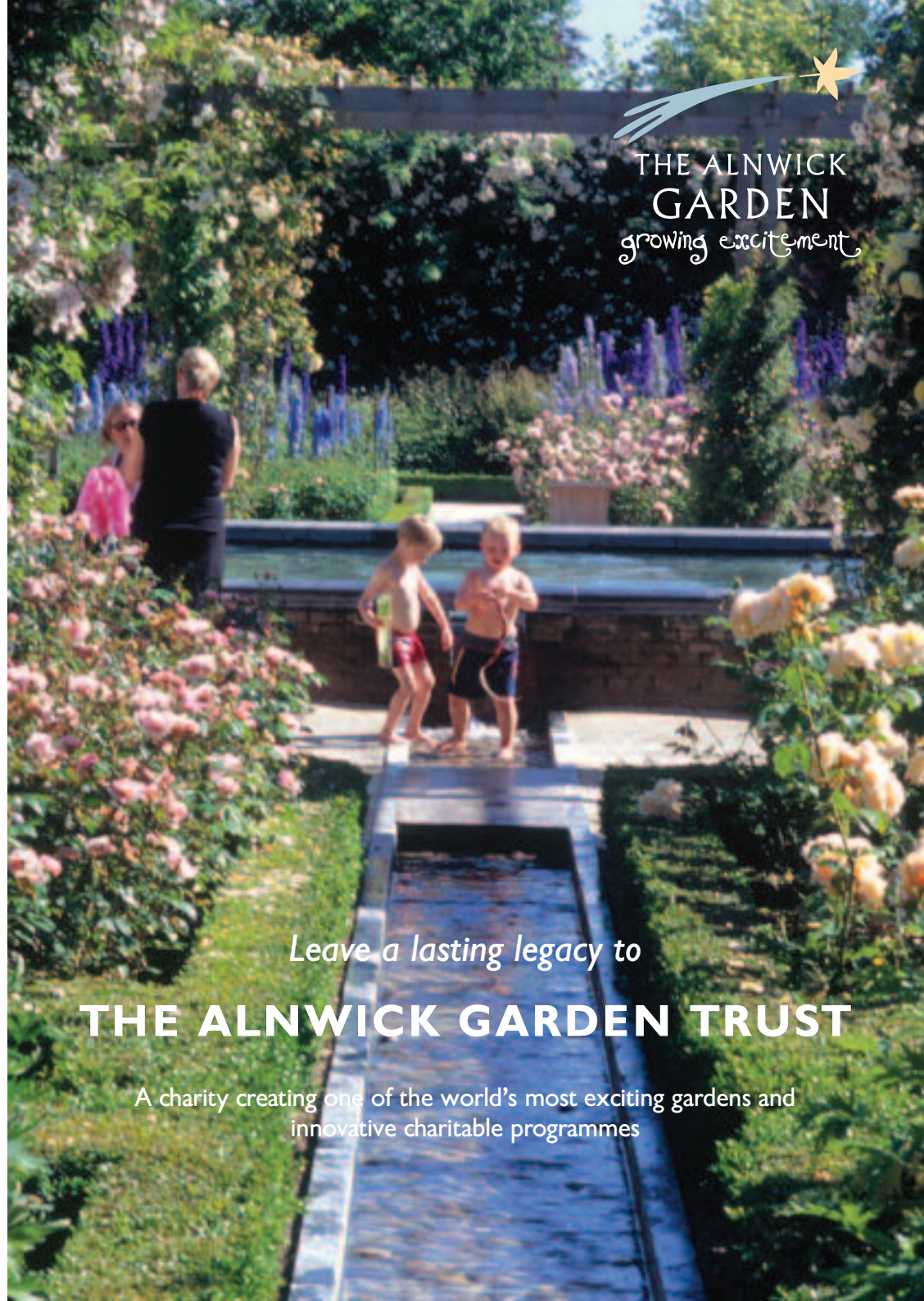

It has taken more than ten years to make The Alnwick Garden what it is today, and we estimate that it will take at least a further five years to complete it. A great deal has already been invested in this project and we want to ensure that the world-class design and features are maintained to the high standard that we strive for and that our visitors expect.

**Your gift can help us to do this.**

Of course, The Garden is much more than simply a visitor attraction, and the community benefits it brings are further enhanced by our charitable projects:

**Roots & Shoots programme:** promotes gardening as a healthy outdoor activity for children as well as adults, and encourages the use of local fresh produce in cooking to inspire people to eat more healthily.

**Arts & Education programmes:** cover a range of subjects and interests, giving people of all ages the opportunity to gain new experiences and try different things.

**Elderberries programme:** encourages older people to be more socially and physically active with a series of educational and invigorating pursuits, aiming in particular to tackle the isolation which is prevalent in many of the rural town and villages of Northumberland and to improve the health and well-being of our older generation.



You don't have to donate a huge amount to make a difference. Here are some examples of how your gift can help:

- £40 provide an exercise/dance class
- £100 purchase tools and seeds for our Roots and Shoots programme
- £250 sponsor a cherry tree in the Cherry Orchard
- £500 enable a small school group to take part in a theatrical workshops and performance
- £1,500 fund a tea dance for the Elderberries project
- £2,000 sponsor a family day with activities and play for children and their carers
- £2,500 enable the purchase of a motorised scooter for use in The Garden
- £10,000 provide intensive training and paid work placements for ten unemployed people
- £20,000 provide play equipment and specialised disability components for The Treehouse Play Area
