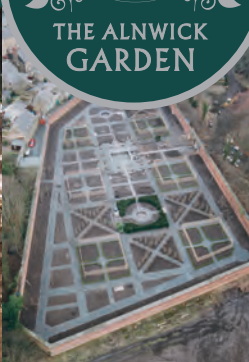
2026 is a big year for us at The Alwick Garden.

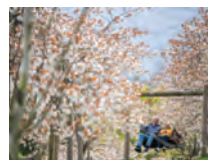
Enjoy the displays of **The Sage Wealth Management Grand Cascade** with 120 water jets.

An evening of music with the Coquet Concert Band, featuring traditional favourites, movie soundtracks and the unveiling of our 25th anniversary composition.



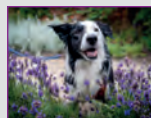
